SCOTTISH TRUNK ROAD NETWORK MANAGEMENT CONTRACT - NORTH WEST UNIT

A84 DOBBIES STIRLING - UNCONTROLLED PEDESTRIAN CROSSING

BEAR Scotland, on behalf of Transport Scotland, are proposing to commence works to improve road infrastructure on the A84 Trunk Road at Dobbies Stirling.

The works involve installing an uncontrolled pedestrian crossing which will comprise of a refuge island, dropped kerbs and tactile paving. The road markings and studs along this stretch of road will also be refreshed and signs warning road users of the new crossing installed. The works are set to commence on Wednesday 1st October and will last for approximately 12 working days.

Typical working hours will be between 0800 to 1800 hrs, Monday to Friday, with no works presently planned for the weekends. Emergency access will be always available throughout the works.

To ensure the safety of the workforce, pedestrians and motorists, traffic will be controlled by temporary traffic signals, taking traffic down to a single lane for the duration of the works. TM will be removed outwith working hours where possible. Pedestrian arrangements will also be in place to guide non-motorised users through the works at all times.

BEAR Scotland and Transport Scotland wish to thank the local community in advance for their patience while this vital infrastructure is installed.
